- Additional related education considered in lieu of experience on a one-for-one basis.
- Special Requirement: Some positions require eligibility for professional designation.

Assets:

- Thorough familiarity with Alberta's legislative framework, including the Forests Act, Forest and Prairie Protection Act, Alberta Land Stewardship Act.
- In-depth working knowledge of forestry policies and forest management planning processes.
- Understanding of forest resilience, climate action, disaster risk reduction, and scientific research methodologies.
- Completion of post-secondary training in project management, climate change mitigation, and adaptation is considered an asset.
- Additional requirements include:
- A valid Class 5 Driver's License or equivalent
- Standard First Aid with CPR Certification
