- Liaise with internal and external stakeholders, and promote local aboriginal initiatives.

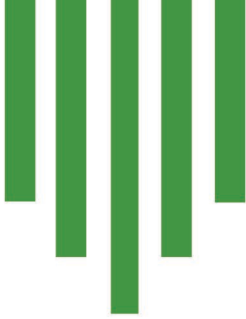
