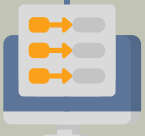


PROFESSIONAL EXAMINATION FAQs



1 Is Writing the Exam Mandatory?

FIT and FTT's are not required to write the professional exam. If registrants are aiming to become fully regulated as an RPF or RPFT, the exam is one of the registration requirements to demonstrate competence.

2 Purpose of the Exam

The professional exam is a multiple-choice, scenario-based assessment that evaluates candidate's knowledge of Alberta's forestry legislation, regulations, and policies. The exam is one of the tools used to determine if a candidate is competent to practice as a fully regulated professional.



3 Eligibility Requirements

Foresters-in-Training (FIT) and Forest Technologists-in-Training (FTT) must complete the five-module Initial Professional Development Program before they can register to write the exam. Individuals who had gaps identified in competency assessments must complete all other assessment requirements prior to writing the exam.

- Registered Professional Foresters (Conditional) (RPF-C)
- Registered Professional Forest Technologists (Conditional) (RPFT-C)

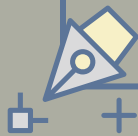

Candidates will have access to study resources:

- Professional Exam Preparation Course (required)
- Professional Exam Study Resources Course
- Access to testable documents with relevant topics

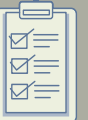
Engagement with mentors and peers is encouraged to support preparation.



6 Exam Location

The exam is delivered online and proctored remotely. Candidates select a location that has a stable internet connection and a distraction-free environment. Locations must be submitted to and improved AAFMP.
